## **Inspiring Change Awards**

Nominations can be made by either an organisation or an individual.

The person being nominated must either work or live in Barnsley. They will have displayed exceptional commitment, effort or creativity to inspire change for gender equality in Barnsley. They will have done more than would usually be expected either in their work, when volunteering or being involved in their community and helping others.

Nominations can be made in any of the following categories:

#### **Changing Attitudes**

For people who have worked to challenge and reduce sexual harassment and violence.

#### **Future Champions**

For young people (age 25 or under) who have championed gender equality and inspired others.

#### **Making the Links**

For people who have promoted equality for women who face multiple discrimination (intersectionality).

#### **Breaking Through**

For people who have challenged stereotypes about what men and women can do in the workplace.

#### **Stronger Communities**

For people who have worked with women or girls to build their capacity to have a voice, support each other and promote equality.

#### Keeping the Flame Alive

For people who have worked tirelessly for gender equality over a long period of time.
