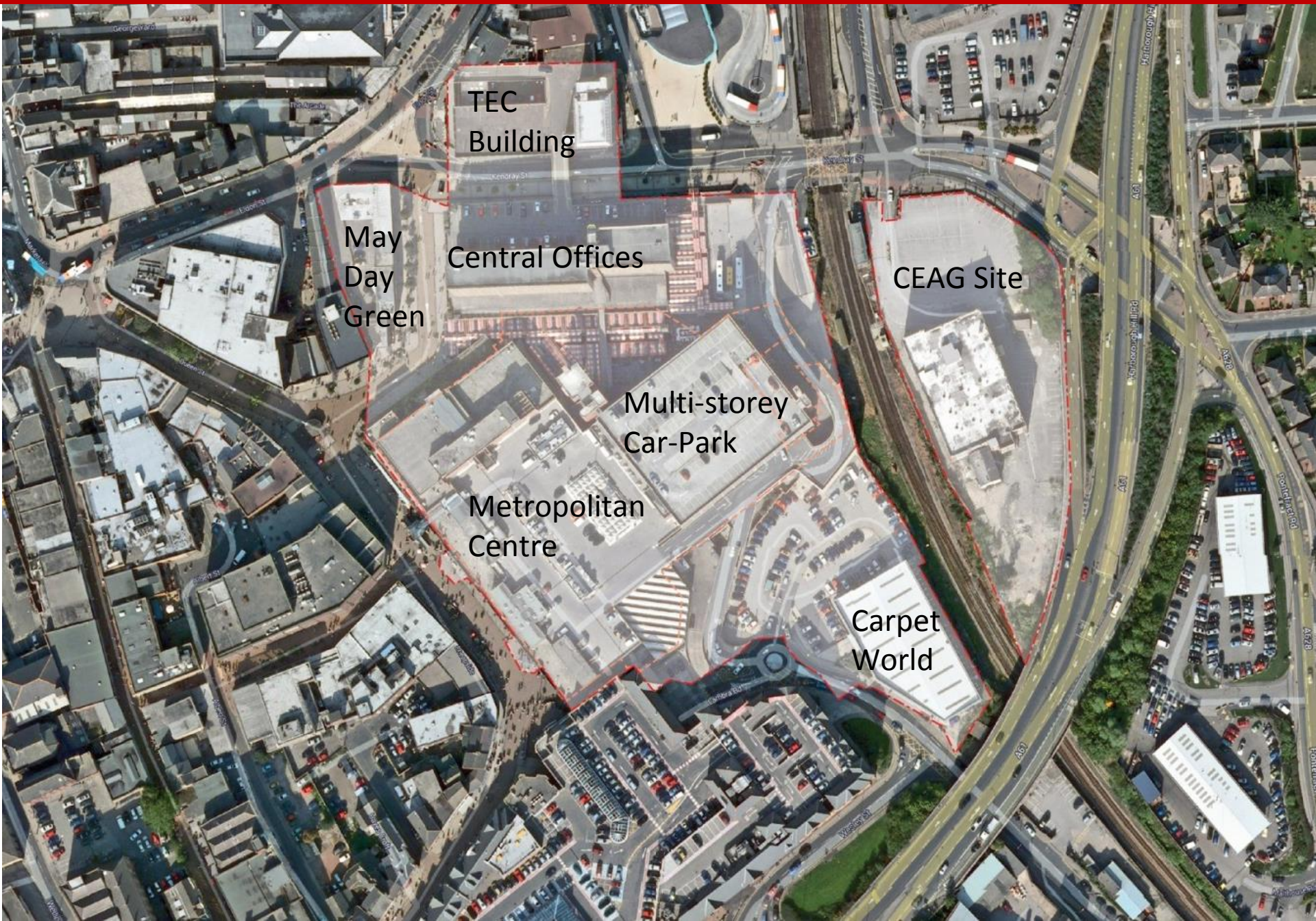

Barnsley Council will

- Invest £41million:
 - Demolish Central Offices and Carpet World
 - Demolish the TEC building
 - Upgrade the Metropolitan Centre and Markets.
 - Build a new Central Library,
 - Create a new car park on the former CEAG site
 - Improve public realm and create a new public square with space for town centre events.
- Work with Network Rail on possible replacement of Jumble Lane Crossing

Feedback from the Disability Equality Forum:

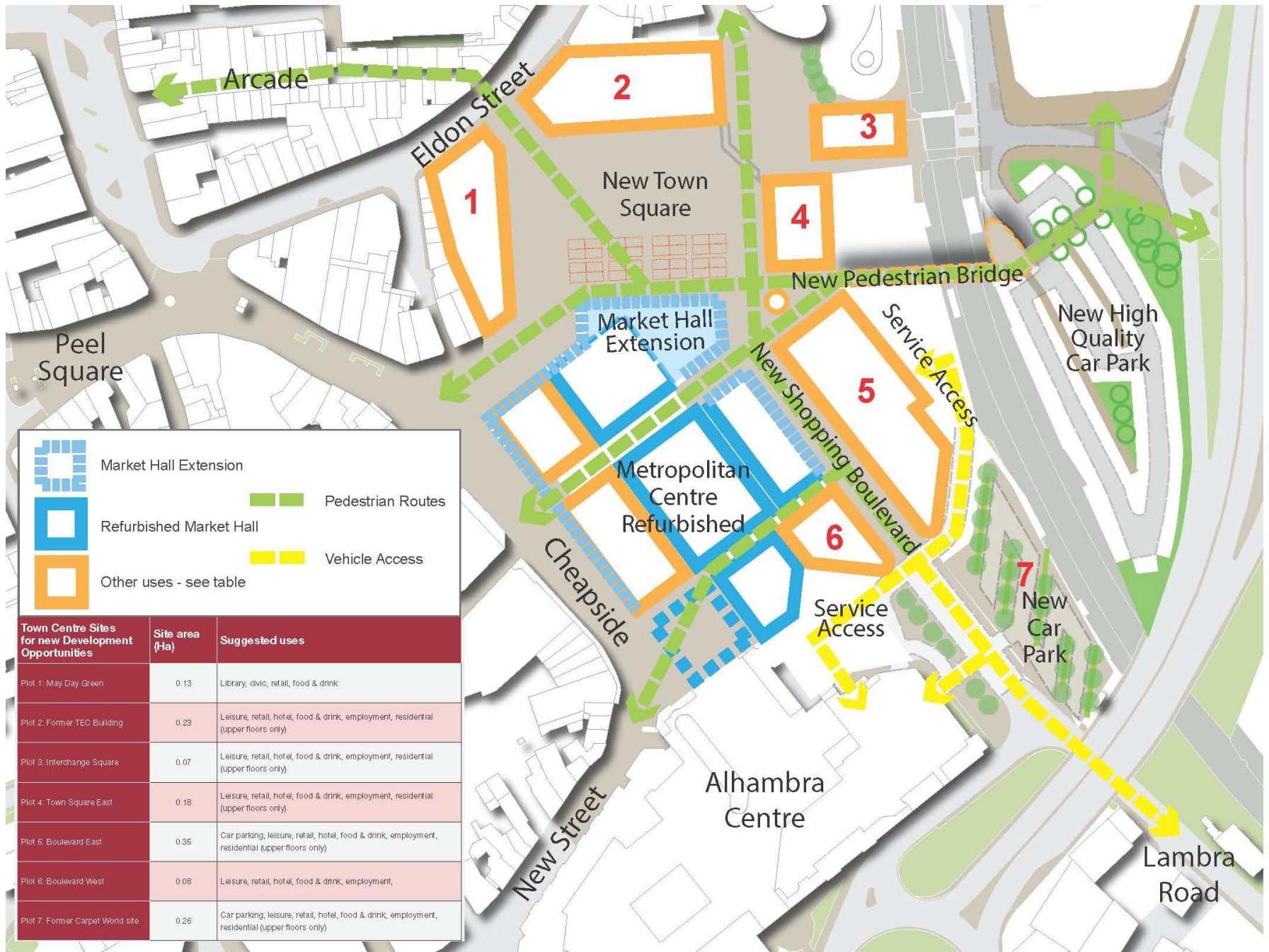
- Improvements to the town centre are welcomed
- An adult 'Changing Places' facility is essential
- Improvements required to access routes around town
- Install automatic doors with wider openings to buildings
- Ramps should have support railings
- Tactile paving should be used near steps
- New disabled toilet provision required
- The bridge over Jumble Lane crossing will be an improvement, it needs to have 2 lifts.
- Creation of a safe place / quiet refuge




How the consultation feedback is used:

- The details of all consultation comments are recorded electronically.
- The feedback from all consultation groups is collated into themed groups. Facilities, public realm, design, retail, leisure etc.
- The collated feedback is then passed to the design team to inform the developing project designs.
- The aim is to ensure that key priorities are recognised within the finished project.

Plot 1: May Day Green	0.13	Library, civic, retail, food & drink
Plot 2: Former TEC Building	0.23	Leisure, retail, hotel, food & drink, employment, residential (upper floors only)
Plot 3: Interchange Square	0.07	Leisure, retail, hotel, food & drink, employment, residential (upper floors only)
Plot 4: Town Square East	0.18	Leisure, retail, hotel, food & drink, employment, residential (upper floors only)
Plot 5: Boulevard East	0.35	Car parking, leisure, retail, hotel, food & drink, employment, residential (upper floors only)
Plot 6: Boulevard West	0.08	Leisure, retail, hotel, food & drink, employment,
Plot 7: Former Carpet World site	0.26	Car parking, leisure, retail, hotel, food & drink, employment, residential (upper floors only)
